 - C. A hearing pursuant to either subpart A. or B. shall be expedited but will be held only after both the 20 days' notice and the newspaper notice are given as required by §34-60-108, C.R.S. However, the hearing can be held after the newspaper

notice if all of the entities listed under Rule 503.b. waive the 20-day notice requirement.

 Rule 503.d. provides that upon the filing of an application, the Secretary shall set the matter for hearing and ensure that notice is given.
