• On May 4, 2018, Applicant filed a verified concurrent Application for Additional Wells pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to approve an additional six horizontal wells, for a total of up to eight horizontal wells, in the approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the productive interval of any horizontal well to be located be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the unit and not less than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well within the unit, and authorizing up to two well pads in the unit, or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
