- 1) Establish DSU No. 1 as an approximate 960-acre DSU for the Codell, Niobrara and Greenhorn Formations pursuant to Rule 503.b.(1) and C.R.S. §34-60-116(2)., and approve up to six horizontal wells in the Codell Formation, 11 horizontal wells in the Niobrara Formation, and one horizontal well in the Greenhorn Formation, with the treated intervals of the wellbores to be not less than 150 feet from the north and south boundaries of DSU No. 1, not less than 460 feet from the east and west boundaries of DSU No. 1, and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well producing within the same formation in DSU No. 1, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 2) Establish DSU No. 2 as an approximate 1,081.23-acre DSU for the Codell and Niobrara Formations pursuant to Rule 503.b.(1) and C.R.S. §34-60-116(2), and approve up to three horizontal wells in the Codell Formation, and nine horizontal wells in the Niobrara Formation, with the treated intervals of the wellbores to be not less than 150 feet from the north and south boundaries of DSU No. 2, not less than 460 feet from the east and west boundaries of DSU No. 2, and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well producing within the same formation in DSU

No. 2, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
