APPLICATION

On June 27, 2018, Crestone Peak Resources Operating LLC (Operator No. 10633) ("Crestone" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to Rule 318A.e(5)C for an order to:

- 1) Grant a hearing on Applicant's ten Echeverria Rule 318A.a(4)D horizontal wellbore spacing units;
- 2) Upon such hearing, approve Applicant's ten Echeverria Rule 318A.a(4)D horizontal wellbore spacing units;
- 3) Upon such hearing, deny Kerr-McGee Oil and Gas Onshore LP's Objections to Applicant's ten Echeverria Rule 318A.a(4)D horizontal wellbore spacing units; and
- 4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A was amended to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A was amended to, among other things, address drilling of horizontal wells and Rules 318A.a(4)D and 318A.e(5) were adopted. Rule 318A.e(5) addresses notice and hearing procedures, and allows an operator to seek a hearing before the Commission on an objection.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to §§ 34-60-101 to 130, C.R.S., and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled this matter for hearing on:

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of September 3, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
