- 2) Provide that the Commission's pooling order is made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b) are first incurred for the drilling of each Well in WSU #1 through WSU #9 for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations on the Application Lands; and
- 3) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.
