APPLICATION

On July 19, 2018, Longs Peak Resources, LLC (Operator No. 10611) ("LPR" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

1) Establish an approximate 1,191.94-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and authorize the drilling of up to six (6) horizontal wells within the proposed unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations, and up to seven (7) horizontal wells within the proposed unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation;

2) Provide that the treated intervals of the wellbore of any well permitted to the Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations to be located not less than 400 feet from the eastern and western boundaries of the proposed unit, not less than 300 feet from the northern and southern boundaries of the proposed unit, and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well producing from within the same unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director; and

3) Provide that the treated intervals of the wellbore of any well permitted to the Niobrara Formation to be located not less than 300 feet from the outer boundaries of the proposed unit, and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well producing from within the same unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

- Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of September 3, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
