#### <u>APPLICATION</u>

On July 19, 2018 (amended August 8, 2018), Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Great Western" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Approve an additional four horizontal wells, for a total of up to 24 wells within an approximate 906.46-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Section 5 and the E½ of Section 6, Township 1 South, Range 66 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations;
- 2) Provide that the productive interval of each proposed horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the northern, southern, and eastern boundaries of the unit (regardless of the lease lines within the unit), no closer than 150 feet from the western boundary of the unit (regardless of the lease lines within the unit), and all horizontal wells shall be no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well producing from the same source of supply within the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director, and providing that the surface location for the additional wells shall be located on no more than one (1) pad location adjacent to the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director;
- 3) Find that the additional wells and reduced setback for the development of the Niobrara and Codell Formations on the Application Lands will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and maximize the efficient and economic production of the Niobrara and Codell Formations on the Application Lands; and
- 4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On December 12, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1844 which established a 906.46-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands for production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations, approved up to 20 horizontal wells within the unit, and required that the productive interval of each wellbore shall be no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore producing from the Niobrara or Codell Formations and no closer than 460 feet from a unit boundary.
- On December 12, 2016, the Commission entered an Order No. 407-1845 which pooled all interests in an approximate 906.46-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, and subjected any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., for the drilling of the Ottesen LE 06-370HC Well, Ottesen LE 06-290HN Well, Ottesen LE 06-290HN Well, Ottesen LE 06-090HN Well, Ottesen LE 06-351HN Well, Ottesen LE 06-290HC Well, Ottesen LE 06-170HC Well, Ottesen LE 06-071HN Well, Ottesen LE 06-330HN Well, Ottesen LE 06-330HC Well, Ottesen LE 06-151HN Well, Ottesen LE 06-071HC Well, Ottesen LE 06-330HC Well, Ottesen LE 06-311HN Well, Ottesen LE 06-130HN Well, Ottesen LE 06-130HC Well, Ottesen LE 06-031HC Well, ottesen LE 06-031HC Well, for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations.

Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
