


# WELL LOCATION CERTIFICATE

HAS DETERMINED THE LOCATION OF THE NEWTON 1-4H TO BE 700' FEL AND 250' FNL, AS MEASURED AT NINETY (90) DEGREES FROM THE SECTION LINE OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 9 NORTH, RANGE 61 WEST AND THE BOTTOM HOLE LOCATION TO BE 700' FEL AND 600' FSL OF SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 9 NORTH, RANGE 61 WEST, 6TH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO.
