Marathon Oil Company ("Marathon") is proposing to drill the Crow Valley 7-62-24-2H and 7-62-13-2H wells with surface hole locations in Section 24, Township 7 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. Marathon intends to test the Niobrara Formation.

Rule 318A.a. designates five "drilling windows" per quarter section of land in the Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) – 400'x400' boxes in the center of each quarter/quarter section. The surface hole locations ("SHL") of Marathon's proposed horizontal wells are outside of the 318A.a. drilling window. The wells will be located 349' and 320' from the North line of Section 24 instead of in the center of Section 24.
