Kris:

Wesco is requesting closure of the above referenced spill.

As discussed in the initial and supplemental release reports, approximately 3 barrels of crude oil were released from a pipeline on 12-27-2015. The spill was caused when a snowmobiler drove into a pipeline drain valve. The released oil sprayed into the air, mostly being absorbed in the snow which was then a few feet deep around the spill area. Wesco subsequently removed approximately 60 cubic yards of crude oil contaminated material, of which we estimate that 58 cubic yards was snow and the remainder soil.

Wesco has since installed a fence around the drain valve to prevent reoccurrence of the accident. Wesco also recently reseeded the area where the soil was removed. I have attached photos of the location as an attached file.

Wesco is requesting COGCC closure of this spill. Please contact me if you require further information.
