Extraction Oil & Gas, LLC (Extraction) is planning to drill the following wells:

AD-J Evans 5-20-24 (Doc # 401049041), AD-Dairy C7-20-24 (Doc # 401049142),  
AD-J Evans C4-20-24 (Doc # 401049051), AD-Dairy 4-20-24 (Doc # 401049153),  
AD-Double Clutch 1-20-24 (Doc # 401049062), AD-Dairy 5-20-24 (Doc # 401049164),

The surface locations of Extraction's proposed wells have been staked outside of the COGCC Rule 318A.a. Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) Drilling Window. Under the COGCC Rule 318A.c. any new twinning well is to be located within 50 feet of an existing well. The proposed Extraction wells listed above are not within 50 ft of an existing well. Extraction is the surface owner and self-waives Rules 318A.a. & 318A.c.

Extraction respectfully requests the COGCC to review the enclosed information and approve the requested exception to Rules 318A.a & 318A.c. for the Applications for Permits to Drill for the wells on the subject pad. This is the best location for the wells since Extraction wants to keep the wells out of the floodway and 100 year floodplain as much as possible.
