



Application Lands


**Exhibit 2**Mineral Ownership





**Exhibit G-1**Structure Contour Map on the top of the Niobrara Formation





**Exhibit G-2**Isopach Map on the top of the Niobrara Formation




**Exhibit G-3**Cross section showing Niobrara section

This Application requests an order to approve an additional seven (7) horizontal wells, for a total of fifteen (15) horizontal wells, in DSU #1, DSU #2, DSU #3, DSU #4, DSU #5 and DSU #6, to require that the productive interval of each additional proposed horizontal well in each approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit shall be no closer than 300 feet from the boundaries of the unit (regardless of the lease lines within the unit) and all horizontal wells shall be no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well producing from the same source of supply within the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director, and providing that the wells will be drilled from no more than five well pads, including the existing wellpads, in each of the six drilling and spacing units to be located within such unit or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director, consistent with Order No. 421-86 underlying the following lands ("Application Lands"):

#### 1. Exhibit E-1 – OOIP and EUR Calculations

Exhibit E-1 shows OOIP calculations, estimated ultimate recovery, and drainage area for fifteen Niobrara Formation wells drilled in a 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit within the underlying the Application Lands as compared to eight wells drilled in the same drilling and spacing unit. The improved recovery factor by 47% shows the drilling of up to fifteen wells will promote efficient drainage, protect correlative rights and prevent waste in a 1280-acre unit versus only drilling eight wells. These reserves would not be fully recovered without the application of horizontal well technology in a 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit.

#### 2. Exhibit E-2 – Analog Well Evaluation

Exhibit E-2 reflects an evaluation of analog 2-section lateral well results in Table A and 1-section lateral well results in Table B. Estimated ultimate recovery and associated drainage area are calculated through decline curve analysis utilizing available public data and the inclusion of one new well drill by the Fifth Creek underlying the Application Lands. The 2-section lateral analog wells have an average lateral length of 9,261' and average estimated ultimate recovery of 431,333 bbl for the Niobrara Formation, for a drainage per well of 85 acres. The 1-section lateral analog wells have an average lateral length of 4,143' and average estimated ultimate recovery of 191,000 bbl for the Niobrara Formation, for a drainage area per well of 38 acres. These estimates are within a reasonable expected range and support the Application.

#### 3. Exhibit E-3 – Economic Analysis

Economic calculations show in improved value of 50% by drilling on 1280-acre units with total of 15 wells versus not developing the resource in an efficient, scientific manner. This result leads to the conclusion that reserves will not be appropriately accessed or drained in a tight unconventional resource with only eight wells per 1280 acre spacing unit, therefore leaving reserves under-developed and creating waste.

#### **Conclusions**

Based on each drilling and spacing unit area of 1,280 acres, the drainage calculations are consistent with the development of up to fifteen Niobrara horizontal wells. This testimony and attached exhibits support my conclusion that the drilling, completion, and production of up to fifteen horizontal wells within each proposed drilling and spacing unit will increase total recovery and reduce resource waste relative to an eight-well 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit. In addition, the proposed development plan can be accomplished in an economic and efficient manner while protecting correlative rights.
