



## **Bayswater rationalization for the Calvary 19-D Horizontal drilling pad and site.**

- The Calvary 19-D Horizontal drilling pad is planned for efficient and economical development of the north half of Sections 20 and 21 of Section 7N-65W
- 2.0 mile laterals are planned such that an additional pad is not necessary in the future
- This location is rural and outside of urban mitigation areas
- Bayswater has good relations with the property owner of the Calvary site
- Engineered sound walls will be utilized if necessary to protect the surrounding building units during operations
- The surface facilities location has been planned to be outside of the 500' setback required per the COGCC rules and away from the CR 39
- The surface facilities are being placed behind the wellheads and further off of WCR 39 so as to be less of a visual for surrounding neighbors
- Bayswater has Surface Damage and Release Agreement with the current property owner which covers dust control, truck traffic, and sound walls among other items
- Bayswater has looked at other locations to drill the proposed wells but the only real option would have been to move it further to the North or East across CR 39, but both of those options would have been within the interior of an irrigation pivot area which is not a desirable location
- This surface site is located 1.3 miles South of HWY 14 and 2.7 miles North of WCR 74
