I, Inspector Mike Longworth, conducted a follow up to 1/22/2021 inspection doc #701101078 at CAERUS PICEANCE LLC, Chevron 42-5D, Location ID: 335814 in Garfield County, Colorado. Location is in close proximity of Parachute creek and in a High Priority Habitat Area. (Elk Migration Corridor, Elk Winter Concentration Area, Mule Deer Winter Concentration Area).
Action items not addressed from previous inspection:
Location shows signs of lack of stabilization BMP's in some areas (rutting is present).
No evidence of tracking control BMP's.
N39.55098 W-108.12060 Sediment blockage in ditch.
N39.55348 W-108.11985 Sediment build up in culvert outlet. Erosion damage from culvert outlet has exposed pipe line.
Water not draining off road.
Corrective action date was 02/06/2021.
Erosion damage at culvert that has exposed gas line needs immediate attention.
