INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Mallard Exploration proposes to conduct closure of the Pintail Fed 3-15-9HN wellbore and facility - since all that was performed on this well was drilling of the surface hole, the extent of the abandonment work will pertain to the wellbore and nearby soils. No flowlines or facility equipment have been constructed for this well. The Pintail Fed 3-15-9HN wellbore (05-123-46553) Form 6 has been approved; abandonment activity scheduled for early Jun'21 MIRU. Subsequent Form 6 paperwork will be submitted once rig work is complete. Mallard will conduct site investigation activities and field screening of location during closure in accordance with COGCC 900 Series Rules. Should any waste be generated during closure activities, all waste, if any, will be managed and disposed of at a Waste Connections facility in accordance with Rules 905 and 906.
