SUMMARY:

Quandary Consultants, LLC (Quandary) completed noxious weed treatment for Longs Peak Resources LLC (Longs Peak) on July 20, 2022, for the Motu East Location. The herbicides Milestone and Cornerstone Plus were used to target back-pack spray the noxious weed, Dalmatian toadflax (*Linaria dalmatica*). Pictures of the noxious weeds observed are presented.

The treatment was conducted by a certified operator (applicator ID:39385, expiration date 3/9/2026) by the Colorado Department of Agriculture Pesticide Applicator Program.

Noxious weed treatment followed the corrective action outlined in the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) inspection, Doc #697504024, follow up to the field inspection report Doc #697500782.

COGCC Corrective Action 1- A List B Colorado noxious weed, toadflax, was observed flowering throughout different areas of the location. Refer to the attached inspection photos. Comply with Rule 1003.e.(2). Operator shall have a certified, professional weed contractor perform the corrective action work and the Operator shall present proof of certification and experience.
