Gentlemen:

The following is a list of wells within Colorado Interstate Gas Company's (CIG) Flank Gas Storage Field which are not operated by CIG. These wells are operated by Horizon Oil and Gas Corporation (HO&G) with the one exception noted below. Produced oil belongs to HO&G while CIG retains the rights to all produced storage gas. CIG uses one designation for the well while HO&G uses a different well name. All of the listed wells are located in Township 34 South, Range 42 West. Sec. 5.

The Flank #67 is operated by the Coastal Oil and Gas Corporation (CO&G). CIG retains the rights to produced storage gas while CO&G retains the produced oil. Both firms use the name "Flank #67".
