Hey Lexi,

I have upcoming form 4 submittal that falls within Bald Eagle Winter Night Roost, Mule Deer Winter Concentration Area, Mule Deer Severe Winter Range. This is the first time we are trying this pilot here in the basin. We'd like to set a tank for cooling flowback fluid adjacent to the well inside the HPH. This tank will run off the pressure of the well and there is no mechanical pump associated with the operation. The tank will be filled with freshwater and coil inside the tank with carry the produced fluid through the tank. We can set the tank between 10am – 2pm. This will only take a day or two to install. Once the tank is set it will require minimal maintenance and these operations can take place between 10am – 2pm.

The cooling operations will run 24 hours a day, but there should be minimal noise because there are no mechanical motors involved. There is a heat exchanger noted on the drawing. This will not be utilized at this location, we were able to drop it during our planning process. Does CPW have any additional concerns? Feel free to give me a call to discuss.
