## APPLICATION OF REX ENERGY ROCKIES, LLC

The Applicant, Rex Energy Rockies, LLC, ("Rex"), by and through its undersigned counsel, respectfully submits this Application to the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission") for an order establishing a 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for development and production from the Niobrara Formation in the following lands ("Subject Lands"):

Township 10 North, Range 57 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Section 25: All

- 1. Rex is a Delaware limited liability company duly authorized to conduct business in Colorado, and is a registered operator in good standing with the Commission, COGCC Operator Number 10336.
  - 2. Rex owns a substantial leasehold position underlying the Subject Lands.
- 3. The Subject Lands are subject to Commission Rule 318.a. which provides that a well to be drilled in excess of two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet in depth shall be located not less than six hundred (600) feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than one thousand two hundred (1,200) feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same source of supply, unless authorized by order of the Commission upon hearing. There are no other specific Commission Orders applicable to the Niobrara Formation underlying the Application Lands.
- 4. Rex obtained a permit to drill the Shapley #14-25H well, a wildcat well, which was spud March 10, 2011. A plat showing the Shapley #14-25H well's permitted location is attached as Exhibit A. The surface location of the Shapley #14-25H well is approximately 661' FSL and 664' FWL located in the SW¼SW¼ of Section 25, Township 10 North, Range 57 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. The bottomhole location is approximately 660' FSL and 660' FWL located in the SE¼SE¼ of Section 25, Township 10 North, Range 57 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M.
- 5. On information and belief, the Commission has not entered an order establishing drilling and spacing units for production of oil and gas from the Niobrara formation underlying the

Subject Lands. Additionally, on information and belief, the Subject Lands have not been committed to a field by the Commission.

- 6. Colorado Revised Statute Section 34-6-116(4) authorizes the Commission to establish drilling and spacing units in order to prevent or assist in preventing waste, avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, and/or protect correlative rights.
- 7. Rex requests that the Commission establish a 640-acre drilling and spacing unit consisting of the Subject Lands, for the Niobrara Formation.
- 8. The establishment of the proposed drilling and spacing unit will allow efficient drainage of the Niobrara Formation, will prevent waste, will not adversely affect correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of oil and gas from the Subject Lands.
- 9. On February 22, 2010 the Commission entered Order No. 421-1 which established fifty-eight (58) approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units in Townships 11 and 12 North, Ranges 62 and 63 West for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation with no more than one (1) horizontal well to be drilled in each unit. The lands in Order No. 421-1 lie to the northwest of the current Subject Lands. Order No. 421-1 further ordered that the surface location for each horizontal well shall be located anywhere within the unit, provided that the horizontal leg into the Niobrara Formation shall not be closer than 600 feet to the outside boundary of the drilling unit and the terminus of the horizontal leg shall not be any closer than 600 feet to the outside boundary of the drilling and spacing unit without exception being granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.
- 10. On August 12, 2010, the Commission entered Order No. 535-2 approving Rubicon Oil & Gas, LLC's request for one hundred forty-five (145) approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units in Townships 8, 9, 10, and 11 North, Ranges 65, 66, 67 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Weld County, Colorado, for the production of oil and gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations. The lands in Order No. 535-2 are in close proximity to the Subject Lands. Order No. 535-2 further allowed two (2) horizontal wells in each unit, with the initial formation penetration, lateral leg, and terminus (bottomhole location) of the permitted wells no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the unit and the initial formation penetration, lateral leg and terminus (bottomhole location) of the second well not closer than 1,200 feet from the first well.
- 11. On October 21, 2010, the Commission entered Order No. 421-3 approving EOG Resources, Inc.'s request to expand Order No. 421-1 to include an additional eighty-four (84) approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units in Township 12 North, Range 61 West, Townships 10, 11, and 12 North, Range 62 West, Townships 10, 11, and 12 North, Range 63 West, and Townships 11, and 12 North, Range 64 West in Weld County, Colorado for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation with no more than one (1) horizontal well to be drilled in each unit. The lands in Order No. 421-3 are situated in close proximity to the Subject Lands. Order No. 421-3 allowed the surface location for each horizontal well to be located anywhere within the unit, provided that the horizontal leg into the Niobrara Formation shall not be closer than 600 feet to the outside boundary of the drilling unit and the terminus of the horizontal leg shall not be any closer than 600 feet to the outside boundary of the drilling and spacing unit without exception being granted by the Director of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.

- 12. Rex requests the Commission take administrative notice of Order Nos. 421-1, 535-2, and 421-3, specifically as they relate to the Commission's past approval of 640-acre drilling and spacing units for the development of the Niobrara Formation and the location of such units to the Subject Lands
- 13. According to the information and belief of Rex, the names and addresses of the interested parties hereto are set forth in Exhibit B; and the undersigned certifies that copies of this Application will be served on each interested party within seven (7) days of the filling of this application, as required by Rule 503.e.
- 14. A draft hearing notice, verification, and certificate of mailing will be submitted within seven (7) days of the filling of this Application

WHEREFORE, Rex Energy Rockies, LLC respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing on June 27 or 28, 2011, that notice of the hearing be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its Order consistent with Rex's requests as set forth above.


