Nickel Road Operating, LLC (Operator No. 10669), together with Cobalt Oil & Gas, LLC and Prelude Petroleum, LLC, both of which are affiliates of Nickel Road Operating, LLC under common ownership and control (together, "Nickel Road" or "Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Jost Energy Law, P.C., respectfully submits this for an order to pool all interests within an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit, as defined below, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations on the following described lands:

Township 7 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M.

Section 11: All Section 12: All

1,280-acres, more or less, Weld County, Colorado.

Hereinafter "Application Lands"

In support thereof, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a limited liability company duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado, and is a registered operator in good standing with the Commission.
- 2. Applicant is an Owner as defined by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Act, C.R.S. § 34-60-103(7), and the Commission 100 Series Rules, owns leasehold interests and/or has the right to drill and produce from the Application Lands.
- 3. On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with permitted well locations in accordance with the

provisions of Order No. 407-1. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.

- 4. On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A was amended to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A was amended to, among other things, address drilling of horizontal wells but did not prohibit the establishment of drilling and spacing units within the Greater Wattenberg Area. The lands encompassing the Application Lands are subject to Rule 318A for wells drilled and producing in the Codell and Niobrara Formations and are also subject to 460' subsurface setback.
- 5. On August 31, 2017, Applicant filed a corresponding application to establish a 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit ("1,280-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit") for the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- 6. Applicant, pursuant to Commission Rule 530 and/or the provisions of C.R.S. § 34-60-116 (6) and (7), hereby requests an order to pool all interests, including but not limited to, any non-consenting interests, in the Application Lands in the Codell and Niobrara Formations underlying the approximate 1,280-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit established for the Application Lands.
- 7. Applicant requests that the Commission's pooling order be made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b) are first incurred for the drilling of any horizontal well to the Codell or Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands.
- 8. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all persons owning an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Rule 503.e., and that at least thirty-five (35) days prior to the hearing on this matter, each such interest owner not already leased or voluntarily pooled will be offered the opportunity to lease, or to participate in the drilling of any wells within the 1,280-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit, and will be provided with the information required by Rule 530 as applicable.
- 9. In order to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights, all interests in the Drilling and Spacing Unit should be pooled for the orderly development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations, including any non-consenting interests therein.
- 10. The granting of this Application is in accord with the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, found at §§ 34-60-101 et seq., C.R.S., and the Commission Rules.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing in October 2017, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order:

- A. Pooling all interests in the 1,280-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit established for Sections 11 and 12, Township 7 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M. for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- B. Providing that the Commission's pooling order is made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b) are first incurred for the drilling of any horizontal well in the 1,280-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit to the Codell or Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands.
- C. Providing that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of a horizontal well are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-116(6) and (7), and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof with respect to any horizontal well drilled to develop the Codell and Niobrara Formations in the 1,280-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit comprising the Application Lands.
- D. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.
