APPLICATION

Catamount Energy Partners LLC, Operator No. 10464, ("Catamount" or "Applicant"), by its attorneys, Welborn Sullivan Meck & Tooley, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission" or "COGCC") for an order pooling all interests and approving cost recovery pursuant to Section 34-60-116, C.R.S., against all nonconsenting interests in the Morales 34-6-6U #2 well (API No. 05-067-09991) within the established approximate 363-acre drilling and spacing unit covering Lots 1 and 2 of Section 6U and the E/2 of Section 7U, Township 34 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M. (S.U.L.), La Plata County, Colorado for the development and production from the Fruitland Coal seams. In support thereof, Applicant states as follows:

1. Applicant is a limited liability company duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado and is an operator in good standing with the Commission.
2. Applicant owns leasehold interests in the following lands ("Application Lands") and therefore has standing to file this application:

Township 34 North, Range 6 West, N.M.P.M. (S.U.L.)
Section 6U: Lots 1 and 2
Section 7U: E/2

La Plata County, Colorado.

A reference map of the Application Lands is attached hereto.

3. On June 17, 1988, the Commission issued Order No. 112-60, which established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for production of gas from the Fruitland

coal seams, with the permitted well to be located no closer than 990 feet from any outer boundary of the unit, nor closer than 130 feet from any interior quarter section line. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.

4. On December 9, 2008, the Commission issued Order No. 112-215, which allowed up to four (4) wells to be drilled in each 320-acre drilling and spacing unit subject to the Order for the production of gas from the Fruitland coal seams, with the permitted wells to be located no closer than six hundred sixty (660) feet from the unit boundary, with no interior section line setback. The Order further requires that the wells drilled pursuant to this Order must comply with the provisions of the MOU between BP America Production Company and La Plata County. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.

5. On December 14, 2015, the Commission issued Order No. 112-246, which pooled all interests in the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Fruitland Coal seams, effective as of the date of the Application, for the drilling of the Morales 34-6-7 #1 well (API No. 05-067-09972) and subjected all nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of Section 34-60-116(7), C.R.S.

6. On May 8, 2016, pursuant to Order Nos. 112-215 and 112-246, Catamount spud the Morales 34-6-7 #1 well to produce gas and associated substances from the Fruitland Coal seams underlying the Application Lands.

7. Pursuant to Order No. 112-215, Catamount plans to drill and complete the Morales 34-6-6U #2 well (API No. 05-067-09991), with an anticipated spud date in December 2017, within the Application Lands to produce gas and associated substances from the Fruitland Coal seams.

8. Pursuant to the relevant provisions of Section 34-60-116(6) & (7), C.R.S., and COGCC Rule 530, Applicant seeks an order pooling all interests in the Application Lands in the Morales 34-6-6U #2 well for the development and operation of the Fruitland Coal seams.

9. Applicant requests that a pooling order be entered as a result of this Application and that it be made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7)(b)(II), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Morales 34-6-6U #2 well.

10. Applicant certifies that, at least 35 days prior to the date of the scheduled protest deadline for this Application, each owner which Applicant was able to locate, not already leased or voluntarily pooled, will be provided with the well proposal and information required by Rule 530 and tendered a reasonable offer to lease (if an unleased mineral owner), or participate and bear costs associated with the drilling and completion of the Morales 34-6-6U #2 well.

11. The granting of this Application is in accord with the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, found at Section 34-60-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S., and Commission rules.

12. The names and addresses of the interested parties (persons who own an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled, except owners of overriding royalty interest) are attached hereto and marked Exhibit A. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all locatable interested parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Commission Rule 507.b.(2).

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

A. Pooling all interests in the Application Lands in the Morales 34-6-6U #2 well for the development and operation of the Fruitland Coal seams.

B. Providing that the pooling order is made effective as of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Morales 34-6-6U #2 well on the Application Lands, whichever is earlier.

C. Providing that the interests of any owners, with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the Morales 34-6-6U #2 well, are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to Section 34-60-116(7), C.R.S., and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof.

D. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in the premises.

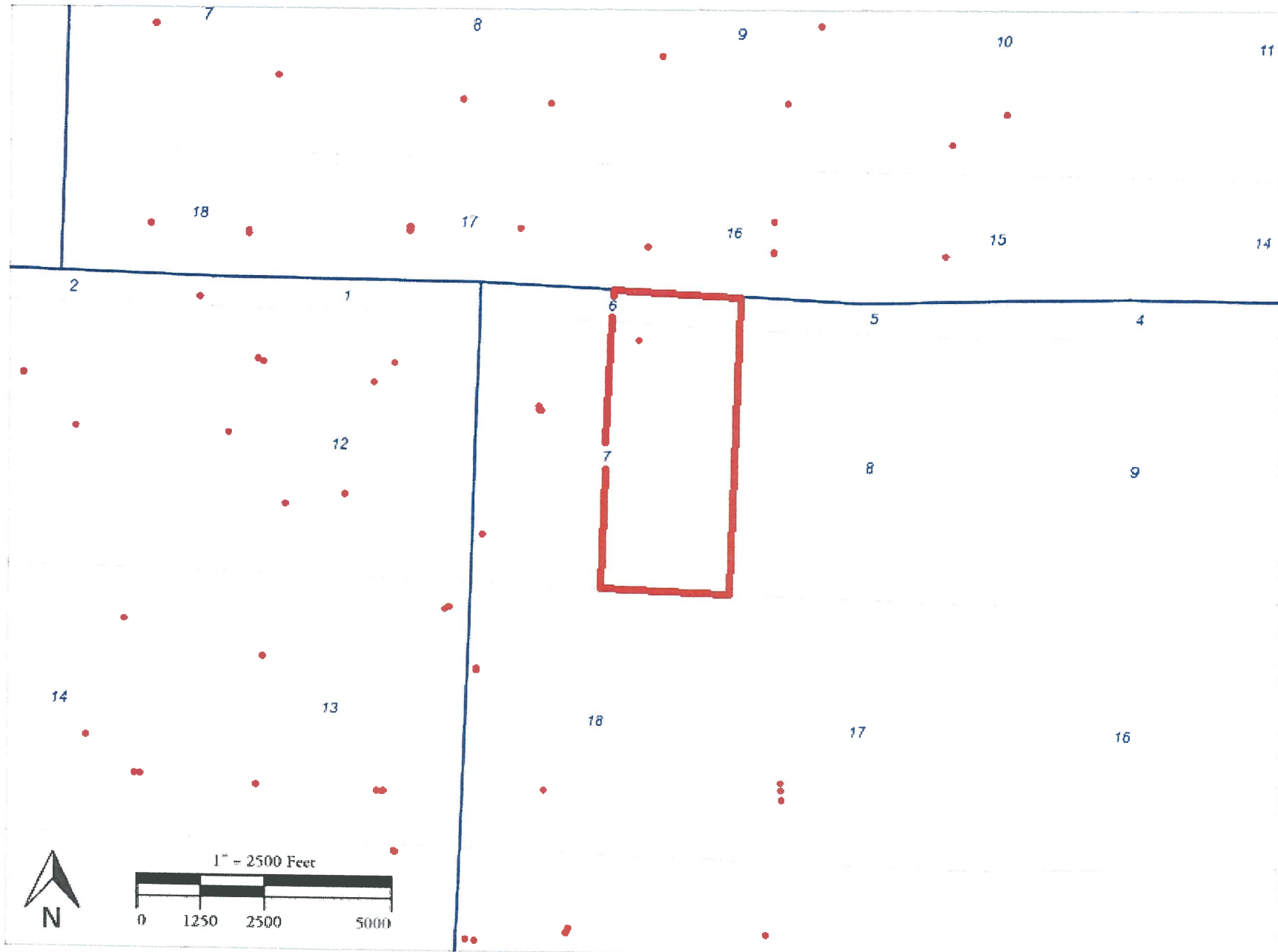
