APPLICATION

Incline Niobrara Partners, LP ("INP"), by and through its attorneys, Fox Rothschild LLP, respectfully submits this Application ("<u>Application</u>") to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("<u>Commission</u>") pursuant to Rule 503.b(10) and C.R.S. § 34-60-118.5 for an order awarding payment of proceeds, interest, costs and attorneys' fees due to INP for production attributable to certain oil and gas wells as described below (collectively, "<u>Subject Wells</u>"), operated by Great Western Operating Company, LLC ("<u>GWOC</u>") and located in Weld County, Colorado.

In support of its application, INP states and alleges as follows:

- 1. INP is a Delaware limited partnership, duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado, but is not authorized by the Commission as an operator.
- 2. Upon information and belief, GWOC is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado, and has registered as an Operator 10311 with the Commission.
- 3. INP is a proper applicant regarding the above-captioned matter, as it is a working interest owner in each of the Subject Wells. INP has standing to file this Application pursuant to Commission Rule 503.b.(10), as it has been adversely affected or aggrieved, and its interests are entitled to legal protection, under the Oil and Gas Conservation Act ("Act") and § 34-60-118.5, C.R.S., as INP is a Payee as defined by the Act.
 - 4. The Subject Wells are identified as follows:

- 5. On or about August 9, 2017, INP sent a Commission Form 37 Payment of Proceeds Information Request ("Commission Form 37") to GWOC regarding the Subject Wells pursuant to § 34-60-118.5, C.R.S., seeking information regarding, among other things, the payment of proceeds, sales volume reconciliation, revenue and deduction detail. See Commission Form 37, attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit 1**; see Proof of Receipt, attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit 2**.
- 6. GWOC contacted INP via electronic mail on August 23, 2017 regarding the the Commission Form 37, having acknowledged receipt in the exchange incorporated herein as **Exhibit 3**. However, no information was provided concerning INP's Commission Form 37 requests at the time or any mention of the requested information moving forward.
- 7. Due to the failure by GWOC to adequately respond to INP's Form 37 request, INP maintains that it has been forced to file this Application requesting a hearing pursuant to § 34-60-118.5, C.R.S., Commission Rule 503.b.(10), and Commission Form 38 Hearing Request for Hearing ("Commission Form 38"), due to GWOC's non-cooperative treatment of INP. See Commission Form 38, attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit 4**.
- 8. INP acknowledges that Commission Form 38 is the Commission's procedural requirement for seeking a hearing on an unresponsive or inadequate Commission Form 37 response, failure to pay proceeds or interest, or late payment.
- 9. In this instance however, Commission Form 38 does not adequately convey INP's claims for relief, as the same arise from each of the 5 categories identified on Commission Form 38 Request for Hearing. As such, INP files this Application in order to address all of INP's concerns arising from GWOC's failure to respond to Commission Form 37.

- 10. § 34-60-118.5 (2.3)(a)-(i), C.R.S. provides that, notwithstanding any other applicable terms or arrangements, every payment of proceeds derived from the sale of oil, gas, or associated products shall be accompanied by information that includes, at a minimum: (a) a name, number, or combination of name and number that identifies the lease, property, unit, or well or wells for which payment is being made; (b) the month and year during which the sale occurred for which payment is being made; (c) the total quantity of product sold attributable to such payment, including the units of measurement for the sale of such product; (d) the price received per unit of measurement, which shall be the price per barrel in the case of oil and the price per thousand cubic feet or per million British thermal units in the case of gas; (e) the total amount of severance taxes and any other production taxes or levies applied to the sale; (f) the payee's interest in the sale, expressed as a decimal and calculated to at least the sixth decimal place; (g) the payee's share of the sale before any deductions or adjustments made by the payer or identified with the payment; (h) the payee's share of the sale after any deductions or adjustments made by the payer or identified with the payment; and (i) an address and telephone number from which additional information may be obtained.
- 11. § 34-60-118.5 (2.5), C.R.S. provides that, upon written request by the payee, submitted to the payer by certified mail, the payer shall provide to the payee within sixty days a written explanation of those deductions or adjustments, including but not limited to, deductions for liquids and gas volumes, and gas volume deficiency fees, over which the payer has control and for which the payer has information, whether or not identified with the payment, and, if requested by the payee, such meter calibration testing and production reporting records that are required to be maintained by the payer in accordance with § 34-60-106(1)(e), C.R.S.
- 12. Pursuant to § 34-60-118.5 (5)(a)-(c), C.R.S., the Commission shall have jurisdiction to determine the date on which payment of proceeds is due to a Payee, the existence or nonexistence of an occurrence which would justifiably cause a delay in payment, and the amount of the proceeds plus interest, if any, due a Payee by a Payer.
- 13. GWOC has not complied with § 34-60-118.5 (2.3), (2.5) C.R.S., as well as other sections of the Act.
- 14. INP's Application seeks relief from the Commission pursuant to Commission Rule 503.b.(10) for each of the Subject Wells, as INP maintains that its working interest is entitled to legal protection under the Act, and that GWOC's failure to pay proceeds and interest due to INP for the payment due from production attributable to the Subject Wells directly and adversely aggrieves INP.
- 15. INP's Application states a plausible claim for relief as required by *Warne v. Hall*, 373 P.3d 588 (Colo. 2016), whereby the Colorado Supreme Court adopted the "plausible claim for relief" standard used by the United States Court. *Id.* at ¶¶9 & 24. The *Warne* Court adopted the standard that the factual allegations of the complaint must be enough to raise a right to relief above the speculative level and provide plausible grounds for relief. *Id.* INP has a working interest in the Subject Wells, INP has not received payment of proceeds as required by § 34-60-118.5, C.R.S., and GWOC has failed to respond to Commission Form 37 requests as required by § 34-60-118.5, C.R.S.
 - 16. INP has complied with Commission Form 38.
- 17. INP reserves all rights to supplement this Application with additional factual information and/or legal arguments, and to request additional relief.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

- A. Awarding payment of proceeds and interest due to INP for production attributable to the Subject Wells from GWOC;
- B. Awarding attorneys' fees and costs to INP under § 34-60-118.5, C.R.S., or as otherwise allowed under Colorado law;
- C. Granting INP such relief under Commission Rule 503.b.(10) as this Commission may deem proper or advisable;
- D. Providing that relief granted under this Application shall be effective upon oral order by the Commission, relying on Applicant's desire to be bound by said oral order; and
- E. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable.
