HighPoint Operating Corporation (Operator No. 10071) ("HighPoint" or "Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (the "Commission") for an order pooling all interests in an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Sections 26 and 27, Township 5 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation. In support of its Application, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado, and has registered as an operator with the Commission.
 - 2. Applicant owns a leasehold interest in the below-listed lands:

Township 5 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M.

Section 26: All Section 27: All

1,280 acres, more or less, Weld County, Colorado.

These lands are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Application Lands" and depicted in Exhibit A attached hereto.

- 3. On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A. which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A. was amended to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A. was again amended to, among other things, address drilling of horizontal wells. The Application Lands are subject to Rule 318A.
- 4. On May 1, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1977, which, among other things, established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing

unit for the Application Lands, and authorized the drilling of up to 16 horizontal wells for production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

- 5. Pursuant to Order No. 407-1977, Applicant has drilled the below-described wells within the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation:
 - a. Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-0108BS Well (API No. 05-123-45730);
 - b. Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-1609B Well (API No. 05-123-45708);
 - c. Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-1724B Well (API No. 05-123-45711);
 - d. Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-3225B Well (API No. 05-123-45715);
 - e. Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-3340B Well (API No. 05-123-45703);
 - f. Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-4841B Well (API No. 05-123-45706);
 - g. Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-4956B Well (API No. 05-123-45729); and
 - h. Anschutz-Williams 5-61-27-6457BN Well (API No. 05-123-45727).

These wells are hereinafter referred to as the "Subject Wells."

- 6. Acting pursuant to the relevant provisions of §34-60-116(6) & (7), C.R.S., and Rule 530., Applicant seeks an order pooling all interests, including, but not limited to, any nonconsenting interests, in the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.
- 7. Applicant requests that the Commission's pooling order be made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Subject Wells.
- 8. Further, Applicant requests that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the Subject Wells, are made subject to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Subject Wells.
- 9. The granting of this Application is in accord with the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, found at §§34-60-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S., and the Commission rules.
- 10. Applicant requests that relief granted under this Application should be effective on oral order by the Commission, and Applicant hereby agrees to be bound by said oral order.
 - 11. The undersigned certifies that copies of this Application will be served

on each interested party as required by Rule 507 within seven (7) days of the filing hereof, as required by Rule 503.e.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing, this Commission enter its order:

- A. Pooling all interests in the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation, effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Subject Wells.
- B. Providing that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the Subject Wells, are made subject to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Subject Wells.
- C. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in the premises.
