<u>APPLICATION</u>

PDC Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 69175) ("PDC"), by and through its attorneys, Burns, Figa, & Will, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (the "Commission") for an order pooling all interests within an approximate 560-acre Wellbore Spacing Unit, as further defined below, for the drilling of the Ottenhoff 29U-343 Well (API No. 05-123-43644) ("Well"), for the development of the Niobrara formation on the following described lands:

Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M.

Section 28: W½W½ Section 29: E½E½

Section 32: E½NE¼, NE¼SE¼ Section 33: W½NW¼, NW¼SW¼

Weld County, Colorado, containing approximately 560.00 acres ("Application Lands")

In support of its Application, PDC states and alleges as follows:

- 1. PDC is a corporation duly authorized to do business in Colorado and is registered as an operator in good standing with the Commission.
- 2. PDC is an Owner with the right to drill into and produce from the Application Lands.
- 3. On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. Sections 29 and 32, Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M. are subject to this Rule for the Niobrara Formation.
- 4. On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formations, the Codell Formation, and the Niobrara Formation underlying certain lands, including Sections 29 and 32, Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M. with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order 407-1.

- 5. On May 23, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 407-416, which, among other things, pooled all non-consenting interests in an approximate 160-acre wellbore spacing unit for the NW¼ of Section 33 of Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., for the Hoffman B#33-19 Well (API No. 05-123-30870), from the Codell and Niobrara formations. Order No. 407-416 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Well.
- 6. On March 14, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1646, which, among other things, pooled all non-consenting interests in an approximate 720-acre wellbore spacing unit for the S½SE¼ of Section 19, the S½S½ of Section 20, the S½SW¼ and SW¼SE¼ of Section 21, the N½NW¼ and NW¼NE¼ of Section 28, the N½N½ of Section 29, and the N½NE¼ of Section 30, all of Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., for the Schneider 19Q-312 Well (API No. 05-123-39542), from the Niobrara formation. Order No. 407-1646 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Well.
- 7. On March 14, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1647, which, among other things, pooled all non-consenting interests in an approximate 720-acre wellbore spacing unit for the S½SE¼ of Section 19, the S½S½ of Section 20, the S½SW¼ and SW¼SE¼ of Section 21, the N½NW¼ and NW¼NE¼ of Section 28, the N½N½ of Section 29, and the N½NE¼ of Section 30, all of Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., for the Schneider 19Q-202 Well (API No. 05-123-39541), from the Niobrara Formation. Order No. 407-1647 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Well.
- 8. On August 20, 2018, the Commission entered Order No. 407-2538, which, among other things, pooled all non-consenting interests in an approximate 720-acre wellbore spacing unit for the S½N½ and N½S½ of Section 32, the S½N½ and N½S½ of Section 33, and the SW¼NW¼ and the NW¼SW¼ of Section 34, all of Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., for the Bath-Schmier 1C Well (API No. 05-123-45072), the Bath-Schmier 2N Well (API No. 05-123-45077), the Bath-Schmier 3N Well (API No. 05-123-45078), and the Bath-Schmier 4N Well (API No. 05-123-45074), from the Niobrara and Codell formations. Order No. 407-2538 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Well.
- 9. On August 20, 2018, the Commission entered Order No. 407-2565, which, among other things, pooled all non-consenting interests in an approximate 720.42-acre wellbore spacing unit for the S½ of Section 32, the S½ of Section 33, and the W½SW¼ of Section 34, all of Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., for the Bath-Schmier 5N Well (API No. 05-123-45067), the Bath-Schmier 6N Well (API No. 05-123-45076), and the Bath-Schmier 7N Well (API No. 05-123-45081) from the Niobrara formation. Order No. 407-2565 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Well.
- 10. On August 20, 2018, the Commission entered Order No. 407-2566, which, among other things, pooled all non-consenting interests in an approximate 360-acre wellbore spacing unit for the $5\frac{1}{2}5\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 32, the $5\frac{1}{2}5\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 33, and the $5\frac{1}{2}5\frac{1}{2}$

SW¼ of Section 34, all of Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., for the Bath-Schmier 8N Well (API No. 05-123-45084), the Bath-Schmier 9N Well (API No. 05-123-45085) from the Niobrara formation. Order No. 407-2566 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Well.

- 11. As of the date of this Application, the COGCC has not published any additional orders affecting spacing of the Application Lands.
- 12. PDC designated an approximate 560-acre Wellbore Spacing Unit for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara formation as provided by Rule 318A and notified the appropriate parties under Rule 318A.
- 13. Under the provisions of Rule 530 and C.R.S. § 34-60-116(6)–(7), PDC requests an order pooling all interests, including the ability to drill through all tracts, in the Application Lands for the development of the Niobrara formation underlying an approximate 560-acre Wellbore Spacing Unit for the Ottenhoff 29U-343 Well (API No. 05-123-43644):

Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M.

Section 28: W½W½
Section 29: E½E½

Section 32: E½NE¼, NE¼SE¼ Section 33: W½NW¼, NW¼SW¼

Weld County, Colorado ("Wellbore Spacing Unit" in this Application)

- 14. PDC requests that the Commission's pooling order be made effective as of the earlier date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b)(II) are first incurred for the drilling of the Ottenhoff 29U-343 Well to the Niobrara formation on the Application Lands.
- 15. PDC certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all owners of the mineral estate, as indicated and required by Rule 507.b(2), underlying the tracts of the Application Lands to be pooled within seven (7) days of the date hereof. The list of Interested Parties is attached as Exhibit A.
- 16. In order to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights, all interests and tracts in the Wellbore Spacing Unit should be pooled for the orderly drilling and development of the Niobrara Formation.

WHEREFORE, PDC respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing at the next available opportunity, that notice be given as required by law, and that the Commission enter an Order:

A. Pooling all interests in the Application Lands and the Wellbore Spacing Unit for the development of the Niobrara Formation;

- Providing that the Commission's pooling order is made effective as of the earlier date of the Application, or the date that the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b)(II) are first incurred for the drilling of the Ottenhoff 29U-343 Well in the Wellbore Spacing Unit to the Niobrara formation on the Application Lands; and
- D. Providing for such other findings and order as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.
