APPLICATION

COMES NOW Mallard Exploration, LLC (Operator No. 10670) ("Applicant"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, and respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (the "Commission") for an order to approve 300-foot reduced setbacks on the unit boundaries of an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Sections 26 and 35, Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. for the efficient and economic production from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations underlying the below-described lands. In support of its Application, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a limited liability company duly organized and authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado and is a registered operator in good standing with the Commission.
- 2. Applicant is an Owner as defined by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Act and Commission Rules and owns leasehold interests or holds the right to operate on the following lands (hereafter "Application Lands"):

Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M.

Section 26: All Section 35: All

Weld County, Colorado, 1280-acres, more or less.

A reference map of the Application Lands is attached hereto.

3. On April 4, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-8 which established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 26 and 35, Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., and approved one horizontal well within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara

Formation, and approved 600' setbacks on the boundaries of the 1280-acre unit, and 150' inter-well setbacks, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

- 4. On January 23, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 535-136 which pooled all interests within the approximate 1,280-acre unit established for Sections 26 and 35, Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., for the Niobrara Formation.
- 5. On June 17, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-490 which approved an additional 15 wells, for a total of up to 16 horizontal wells, within an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-8 for Sections 26 and 35, Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- 6. On June 17, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-503 which pooled all interests within an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Sections 26 and 35, Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., and subjected any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S. for the drilling of the Cass 26-1H Well, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.
- 7. On October 15, 2018, Bison Oil and Gas II, LLC ("Bison") filed a spacing application in Docket No. 181200914 to modify an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-8 for Sections 26 and 35, Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. to include the Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations and to approve an additional four horizontal wells, for a total of up to 20 horizontal wells, within the established 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations. Bison's Application is currently scheduled for the January 28-29 hearing.
- 8. To promote efficient drainage within the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations of the Application Lands, to protect correlative rights and to avoid waste, the Commission should approve 300-foot reduced setbacks for the boundaries of the approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production, development and operation of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations.
- 9. The above-proposed reduced setbacks will allow efficient drainage of the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations, will prevent waste, will not adversely affect correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of gas and associated hydrocarbon substances from the reservoirs.
- 10. The undersigned certifies that copies of this Application will be served on each interested party, as required by Rule 507.a.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing on March 11-12, 2019, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order to:

- A. Approve reduced productive interval setbacks of not less than 300' from the boundaries of an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Sections 26 and 35, Township 8 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M.
- B. Find that the reduced setbacks on the unit boundaries of the approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the development of the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations on the Application Lands will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and maximize the efficient and economic production of the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell and Carlile Formations on the Application Lands.
- C. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.


