On March 2, 2017, Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP, Operator No. 47120 ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Designate the New Nonconsenting Parties as nonconsenting under the terms of Order No. 407-1667, including the cost recovery provisions thereof, effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. were first incurred for the drilling of the Guest 30N-12HZ Well.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On or about March 7, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1667 which, among other things, pooled all interests in the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation, and subjected any owners with whom the Applicant had been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the Guest 30N-12HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42459) ("Subject Well") to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. were first incurred for the drilling of the Subject Well.


