NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

APPLICATION

On March 1, 2017, Laramie Energy, LLC (Operator No. 10433) ("Laramie" or "Applicant"), filed a verified Application, and on March 22, 2017, filed a verified Amended Application, pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 321.85-acre, more or less, drilling and spacing unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde Group, including the Williams Fork and Iles Formations, Cameo, Rollins, Cozzette and Corcoran Formations (collectively "Mesaverde Group") and approve the equivalent of one well per 10-acre density for all wells producing from the Mesaverde Group, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 2) All wells producing from the Mesaverde Group shall be located no closer than 100 feet from the exterior boundaries of the Application Lands, or 200 feet from the exterior boundaries of the Application Lands if the Application Lands abut or corner lands not subject to 10-acre density, unless an exception is granted by the Director; and
- 3) The wells subject to this Amended Application will be drilled from lands outside the Application Lands or from no more than one well pad per quarter-quarter section within the Application Lands, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

APPLICABLE RULES AND ORDERS

- Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of April 17, 2017.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
