#### <u>APPLICATION</u>

On March 2, 2017, ConocoPhillips Company (Operator No. 19160) ("COPC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Subject additional parties to Order No. 535-767, which pooled all interests in an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation, and subject the nonconsenting parties to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., for the drilling of the Prosper Farms 4-65 2-1 #4AH Well (API No. 05-005-07249) and the Prosper Farms 4-65 2-1 #4CH Well (API No. 05-005-07250); and
- 2) Provide that the Commission's order subjecting additional parties to Order No. 535-767, including the cost recovery provisions of C.R.S. §34-60-116(7), be made effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b)(II), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Prosper Farms 4-65 2-1 #4AH (API No. 05-005-07249) or the Prosper Farms 4-65 2-1 #4CH (API No. 05-005-07250) in the Niobrara Formation.

- On January 27, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-461 which, among other things, established an approximate 1280-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit, and approved up to two horizontal wells within the unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.
- On June 17, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 535-486 which, among other things, pooled all interests in an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Niobrara

Formation, effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in C.R.S. §34-60-116(7)(b)(II) are first incurred for the drilling of the Prosper Farms 4-65 1-2 1H Well and one additional well. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.

- On July 20, 2015, the Commission entered Order No. 535-685 which, among other things, approved an additional two horizontal wells, for a total of up to four horizontal wells, in the approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, providing that the productive interval of the wellbore shall be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception granted by the Director. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.
- On January 30, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 535-767 which, among other things, pooled all interests in an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Wells in the Niobrara Formation, and subjected any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b) are first incurred for the drilling of the Prosper Farms 4-65 2-1 #4AH (API No. 05-005-07249) or the Prosper Farms 4-65 2-1 #4CH (API No. 05-005-07250) for the development of the Niobrara Formation.
