APPLICATION

On April 13, 2017 (**amended August 17, 2017**), Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP (Operator No. 47120) ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant" filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Amend Pooling Order No. 407-1854 to pool the interests in the Additional Lands as well as the Original Lands, being an approximate ~~392.22~~**400**-acre wellbore spacing unit, for development and operation of the Codell Formation, effective as of the earlier of the date of Pooling Order No. 407-1854, or the date the costs specific in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Puma Fed 34C-35HZ Well.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On or about December 12, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1854 which, among other things, pooled all interests in two approximate 360-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units and one approximate 240-acre horizontal wellbore spacing unit, covering the Original Lands, for the development and operation of the Sussex, Codell and Niobrara Formations.
