On May 25, 2017 (Amended June 13, 2017), Noble Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 100322) ("Noble" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application for an order to:

1) Amend Order No. 407-1954 to reduce the interwell setback to allow not less than 100 feet from the productive interval of another well for any of the allowed horizontal wells within the approximate 2,560-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

• On May 1, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1954 which approved, among other things, an approximate 2,560 acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 27, 28, 29 and 30, Township 5 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations and to approve up to 26 new horizontal wells in the approximate 2,560-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of the oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations. Order No. 407-1954 also allowed for interwell subsurface setbacks of "not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well within the unit", unless an exception is granted by the Director.
