On May 25, 2017, Bill Barrett Corporation (Operator No. 10071) ("BBC" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Strike the first sentence of Order No. 407-871, "Order" Paragraph 4.
- 2) Amend Order No. 407-871 to reflect this deletion and issue a revised Order No. 407-871 with an effective date as set forth in the original Order No. 407-871.
- 3) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On October 13, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 407-871 which, among other things, pooled all interests in an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Section 20, Township 6 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M., to accommodate the Greasewood 10-20H Well for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation, effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in C.R.S 34-60-116(7)(b)(II) are first incurred for the drilling of the Greasewood 10-20H Well for the development and operation of the Niobrara formation. See Order No. 407-871, page 2 ("Order" Paragraph No. 1).
- Order No. 407-871 provides that "Any unleased owners are hereby deemed to have elected not to participate and shall therefore be deemed to be nonconsenting as to the Well and be subject to the penalties as provided for by 34-60-116(7), C.R.S. Any party seeking cost recovery provisions of 34-60-116(7), C.R.S, shall first comply with

subsection (d) for any subsequent well(s)." See Order No. 407-871, page 3 ("Order" Paragraph No. 4).
