APPLICATION

On May 25, 2017, Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP (Operator No. 47120) ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116 C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Amend Order No. 407-1878 insofar as it applies to the wellbore spacing unit established for the Whiston 16N-33HZ Well (API No. 05-123-44030) to reflect the as-drilled wellbore spacing unit configuration for the Application Lands; and
- 2) Affirm the pooling provisions of Order No. 407-1878 to all parties within the unit, for development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.

- On January 30, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1878, which among other things, pooled all interests within 10 horizontal wellbore spacing units including an approximate 240-acre wellbore spacing unit designated for the Whiston 16N-33HZ well.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 10, 2017.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
