On May 25, 2017, Laramie Energy, LLC (Operator No. 10433) ("Laramie" or "Applicant"), filed a verified Application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in the approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 429-16 for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde Formation, including the Williams Fork and Iles Formations, Cameo, Rollins, Cozzette and Corcoran Formations ("Mesaverde Formation"); and
- 2) Subject all nonconsenting or unleased interests to the cost recovery provisions of § 34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7), C.R.S. were first incurred for the drilling of the new Nichols wells.

On October 24, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 429-16 which vacated Order No. 429-4 insofar as it applies to the Mesaverde Group within the Application Lands, established the Application Lands as an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit with the equivalent of one well per 10-acre density for all wells producing within the unit and directed that wells within the Application Lands be located no closer than 100 feet from the unit boundary line, or 200 feet from the unit boundary line if the unit abuts or corners lands not subject to 10-acre density, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
