APPLICATION

On August 31, 2017, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Great Western" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying an approximate 1,923.32-acre drilling and spacing unit comprising the Application Lands.

2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of a horizontal well to the Codell or Niobrara Formations in the 1,923.32-acre Drilling and Spacing Unit established for the Application Lands.

3) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations underlying certain lands, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
- On July 11, 2017, Applicant filed an application in Docket No. 170900528 for an order to establish an approximate 1,923.32-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands (the "Drilling and Spacing Unit"), and approve up to 26 horizontal wells in the unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, providing that the productive interval any horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the unit and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well within the unit, and approve up to three well pads within or adjacent to the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director, and providing that the wells shall be drilled on no more than three well pads within the unit subject to Rule 318A or on adjacent lands, unless an exception is granted by the Director. Docket No. 170900528 is scheduled to be heard before the Commission at the September 11-12, 2017 hearing.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of October 16, 2017, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
