APPLICATION

On August 31, 2017, Nickel Road Operating, LLC (Operator No. 10669), together with Cobalt Oil & Gas, LLC and Prelude Petroleum, LLC, both of which are affiliates of Nickel Road Operating, LLC under common ownership and control (together, "Nickel Road" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1. Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands and approve up to 24 new horizontal wells within the proposed unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations;
2. Require that the productive interval of each proposed horizontal well in the approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit shall be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the unit and all horizontal wells shall be no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well producing from the same source of supply within the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
3. Applicant stated that the wells will be drilled from no more than two well pads within the proposed drilling and spacing unit, to be located within such unit or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
4. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara

Formations underlying certain lands, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of October 16, 2017, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
