APPLICATION

On October 12, 2017, Petro Operating Company LLC (Operator No. 10583) ("Petro" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Vacate Order No. 407-1908;
- 2) Establish an approximate 1,241-acre drilling and spacing unit covering the Application Lands and approve up to twenty-four (24) horizontal wells for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and
- 3) Require that the treated interval of each wellbore to be located no closer than 150 feet from the treated interval of any other wellbore producing from the Codell and/or Niobrara Formations and no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundary, without exception being granted by the Director.
- 4) Applicant states that pursuant to a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Brighton, the wells will be drilled from one existing location within the unit.


Additional information about the hearing on this Application will be in the Commission's Agenda, which is posted on the Commission website approximately three (3) days before the hearing.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of November 27, 2017, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Commission Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
