APPLICATION

On October 12, 2017, Highlands Natural Resources Corporation (Operator No. 10625) ("Highlands" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Authorize an additional four (4) horizontal wells, for a total of eight (8) horizontal wells, in an exploratory drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands (as defined below) by Order No. 535-757, for production from the Niobrara Formation;
- 2) Applicant states that the horizontal wells to be drilled in the unit are to be oriented in a general east/west direction and will be drilled from no more than four pads on the surface of the drilling unit, or on adjacent lands with consent of the landowner, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

- On January 30, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 535-757, which established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approved up to four horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the treated intervals of the wells to be no closer than 600 feet from the eastern boundary of the unit, no closer than 300 feet from the northern and southern boundaries of the unit, no closer than 100 feet from the western boundary of the unit, and no closer than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well producing from the same formation, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of November 27, 2017, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
