APPLICATION

On March 1, 2018, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Great Western" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Subject additional parties to Order No. 407-2324, which pooled all interests in eight approximate 1,440-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units established for the above-described Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations.

2) Providing that the Commission's order subjecting additional parties to Order No. 407-2324 is made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in § 34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Postle IC 09-259HN Well in WSU No. 1 (API No. 05-123-46038), the Postle IC 09-299HN Well in WSU No. 2 (API No. 05-123-46041), the Postle IC 09-299HNX Well in WSU No. 3 (API No. 05-123-46040), the Postle IC 09-302HC Well in WSU No. 4 (API No. 05-123-46043), the Postle IC 09-302HN Well in WSU No. 5 (API No. 05-123-46044), the Postle IC 09-342HN Well in WSU No. 6 (API No. 05-123-46039), the Postle IC 09-342HNX Well in WSU No. 7 (API No. 05-123-46037), and the

Postle IC 09-379HC Well in WSU No. 8 (API No. 05-123-46042) ("Wells"), for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.

3) Providing that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of a horizontal well are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to § 34-60-116(6) and (7), C.R.S., and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof with respect to any horizontal well drilled to develop the Niobrara and Codell Formations in the Wellbore Spacing Units comprising the Application Lands.

4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations underlying certain lands, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On January 29, 2018, the Commission entered Order No. 407-2324 which, among other things, pooled all interests in eight approximate 1,440-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations, and subjected any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Wells to the Niobrara or Codell Formations.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of April 16, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
