NOTICE OF HEARING

APPLICATION

On March 12, 2018, ConocoPhillips Company (Operator No. 19160) and its wholly owned subsidiary Burlington Resources Oil & Gas LP (Operator No. 26580) (together, "COPC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Authorize an additional two horizontal wells, for a total of up to four horizontal wells, in an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for production and operation of the Niobrara Formation;
- 2) Require that the productive interval of each horizontal well in the unit be no closer than 460 feet from unit boundary (regardless of the lease lines within the unit), and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well producing within the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director; and
- 3) Require that the wells be drilled from no more than two surface locations within the unit, or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

- On December 11, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 535-899 which, among other things, established an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands and approved a total of two horizontal wells within the unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, providing that the productive interval of the wellbore will be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore producing from the same source of supply within the unit, without exception being granted by the Director, and providing that any horizontal wells to be drilled shall be drilled from

no more than one multi-well pad on the surface of the drilling unit, or on adjacent lands with consent of the landowner, unless an exception is granted by the Director. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of May 28, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
