NOTICE OF HEARING

APPLICATION

On March 13, 2018, ConocoPhillips Company (Operator No. 19160) and its wholly owned subsidiary Burlington Resources Oil & Gas LP (Operator No. 26580) (together, "COPC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Crow 3-64 29-30 3AH, the Crow 3-64 29-30 3BH, the Crow 3-64 29-30 3CH and the Crow 3-64 29-30 3DH (API Nos. Pending) ("Wells").

- On December 11, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 535-899 which, among other things, established an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands and approved a total of two horizontal wells within the unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, providing that the productive interval of the wellbore will be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore producing from the same source of supply within the unit, without exception being granted by the Director, and providing that any horizontal wells to be drilled shall be drilled from no more than one multi-well pad on the surface of the drilling unit, or on adjacent lands with consent of the landowner, unless an exception is granted by the Director. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.

- On March 12, 2018, Applicant filed an Application in Docket No. 180600378 for an order to, among other things, authorize an additional two horizontal wells, for a total of up to four horizontal wells, in an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for production and operation of the Niobrara Formation, and to provide that the productive interval of any horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the unit and not less than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well within the unit, and authorizing up to two well pads in the unit, or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of May 28, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.

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

If you file a protest, you must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of **May 25, 2018**, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.

If you fail to file a timely protest, the Commission may enter an order affecting your

interests in the Application Lands without further notice. This matter may be continued to a future Commission hearing date, but that does not change your protest deadline.
