APPLICATION

On April 12, 2018, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Great Western" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations; and
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the: Dittmer KE 20-033HN, Dittmer KE 20-034HC, Dittmer KE 20-034HN, Dittmer KE 20-035HN, Dittmer KE 20-037HC, Dittmer KE 20-037HN, Dittmer KE 20-038HN, and the Dittmer KE 20-039HC (API Nos. Pending) (the "Wells").

- On April 27, 1988, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. The Application Lands are subject to Rule 318A for the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations underlying certain lands, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the

Niobrara and Codell Formations.

- On March 19, 2018, the Commission entered Order No. 407-2391 which, among other things, established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands and approve eight horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations in the unit; and provided that the productive interval of any horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the unit and not less than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well within the unit, and authorizing one well pad to be located within the unit, or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director. The Application Lands are subject to this Order.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of May 28, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
