2) Deny Kerr-McGee Oil and Gas Onshore LP's Objections to Crestone's 11 Regnier Farms WSUs;

3) Find that the approximate 11 designated Regnier Farms WSUs established for the development of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations underlying the Application Lands will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and maximize the efficient and economic production of the Codell and Niobrara Formations in the Application Lands; and

4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 16, 2018.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
