On August 30, 2018, Noble Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 100322) ("Noble" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

1) Pool all interests, including but not limited to any non-consenting interests and any party failing to fulfill its election, in ten designated horizontal Wellbore Spacing Units established for the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and

2) Provide that the Commission's pooling order is made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b) are first incurred for the drilling of each Well in WSU #1 through WSU #10 for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations on the Application Lands.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order

No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
