APPLICATION

On August 27, 2018, amended September 20, 2018, Enerplus Resources (USA) Corporation (Operator No. 10177) ("Enerplus" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Buffalo 7-65-5-6C Well (API No. pending), the Canada Lynx 7-65-5-6C Well (API No. pending), the Elk 7-65-5-6N Well (API No. pending), the Gray Fox 7-65-5-6C Well (API No. pending), the Grizzly 7-65-5-6C Well (API No. pending), the Mule Deer 7-65-5-6N Well (API No. pending), the Ram 7-65-5-6C Well (API No. pending), and the Ringtail 7-65-5-6C Well (API No. pending).

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On September 11, 2017, the Commission entered Order Nos. 407-2188, which, among other things, established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit, and authorized the drilling of eight horizontal wells within the unit from the Niobrara and Codell Formations within the unit for production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons, and required the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore producing from the same source of supply within the unit, with the horizontal wells

to be drilled from no more than two multi-well pads on the surface of the drilling unit, or on adjacent lands with consent of the landowner, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of October 15, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
