APPLICATION

On August 30, 2018, Noble Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 100322) ("Noble" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Establish an approximate 1,920-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approve the drilling of up to 23 horizontal wells within the proposed unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations, with the treated intervals of the wellbore of any well permitted to the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations to be located not less than 200 feet from the northern and southern boundaries of the proposed unit, and not less than 300 feet from the eastern and western boundaries of the proposed unit, and not less than 150 feet from the treated interval of another well producing from within the same unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

2) Require that the wells be drilled from no more than three well pads for the proposed unit, to be located within the unit or on adjacent lands.

3) Any permitted wells to be drilled under this Application shall be drilled in a north-south or south-north wellbore orientation.
