APPLICATION

On August 30, 2018, Bison Oil & Gas II, LLC (Operator No. 10661) ("Bison" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to modify Order No. 535-963 only as to the well setbacks such that the treated interval of each authorized wellbore be located no closer than 300 feet from the unit boundary, and no closer than 100 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located within the drilling and spacing unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

APPLICABLE ORDERS AND RULES

(available online at: http://cogcc.state.co.us, under "Regulation," then select "Orders" or "Rules")

- Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply.
- On February 22, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-3, which established 160 approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands in Townships 8, 9, and 10 North, Ranges 58, 59, 60, 61, and 62 West, 6th P.M., and approved one horizontal well in each unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the initial perforation and the ultimate bottomhole location of the wellbore to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundary, without exception being granted by the Director.
- On March 19, 2018, the Commission entered Order No. 535-963, which vacated two 640acre drilling and spacing units established by Order No. 535-3 for the Application Lands and established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit covering the Application Lands, and approved up to 20 horizontal wells within the unit, for the

production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations with the productive interval of the wellbores to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 100 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, unless the Director grants an exception.

Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
