APPLICATION

On August 30, 2018, Petroshare Corp. (Operator No. 10454) ("PetroShare" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S. ("Application"), for an order to:

1) Pool all interests within the approximate 640.00-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formations, with the pooling order effective as of the date of the Application; and

2) Provide that the interests of any owners, with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of certain authorized wells, for production oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formations, having been pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to §34-60-116(6) & (7), C.R.S., are made subject to cost recovery and risk penalties provided therein, for the drilling and operation of eight (8) horizontal wells within the Application Lands (the "Brighton Lake Wells");

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Commission Rule 318A, which among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. Commission Rule 318A supersedes all prior Commission drilling and spacing orders affecting well location and density requirements of GWA wells. On December 5, 2005, Commission Rule 318A was amended to, among other things, allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Commission Rule 318A was again amended, among other things, to address drilling of horizontal wells. The Application Lands are subject to Commission Rule 318A for the Codell-Niobrara Formations.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of October 15, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
