APPLICATION

On August 30, 2018, Upland Exploration, LLC (Operator No. 10701) ("Applicant" or "Upland"), filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit for the N½ of Section 21, Township 11 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell, Carlile, Fort Hays and Niobrara Formations;
- 2) Approve up to seven new horizontal wells in the approximate 320-acre unit; and
- 3) Provide that the productive interval of any horizontal well in the unit shall be no closer than 300 feet from the boundaries of the unit, with 150 feet inter-well setbacks from any wellbore within the unit.

- Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. The N½ of Section 21, Township 11 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., is subject to this Rule for the Codell, Carlile, Fort Hays and Niobrara Formations.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of October 15, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
