APPLICATION

On September 20, 2018, Nickel Road Operating LLC (Operator No. 10669), together with Nickel Road Development LLC which is an affiliate of Nickel Road Operating LLC under common ownership and control (together, "Nickel Road" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1,120-acre drilling and spacing unit for Section 5 and the W½ and SE¼ of Section 4, Township 6 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., and approve up to 32 new horizontal wells in the proposed approximate 1,120-acre drilling and spacing unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
- 2) Provide that the productive interval of each proposed horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the proposed unit, and all horizontal wells shall be no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well producing from the unit, unless the Director grants an exception.
- 3) Provide that no more than two new well pads be approved in the unit, or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 4) Find that the approximate 1,120-acre drilling and spacing unit for the development of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations underlying the Application Lands will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and maximize the efficient and economic production of the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
- 5) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- On January 26, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1597 which, among other things, pooled all interests in three approximate 320-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units established for portions of Sections 5, 6, 7, and 8, Township 6 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., and subjected all nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., for the drilling of the Janssen #1 Well, the Janssen #2 Well, and the Janssen #3 Well, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations. Order No. 407-1597 is wellbore specific and does not affect this Application.
