Amend Pooling Order No. 407-2298 to account for the adjustment to WSU No. 3, the Bison Ridge Y22-779 Well (API No. 05-123-45378), and thereby pool the interests in the Application Lands, being an approximate 360-acre wellbore spacing unit for development and operation of the Niobrara and Sharon Springs Formations, effective as of the earlier of the date of Pooling Order No. 407-2298, or the date the costs specific in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Bison Ridge Y22-779 Well.
